# Interagency Edison (iEdison II) Release Notes

Version 2.0.13 – January 20, 2006

# Issues Resolved in this Release

Listed below are issues in which errors have been fixed for this release of iEdison Extramural Web.

- Previously, when registering an Organization in Extramural Web, no error message displayed for bad format entry of commas, thus displaying incorrectly in Process Registration and in Powerbuilder. The error message now displays in both systems.
- The system now accepts entering two Grant Numbers upon creating an invention, where both Grant Numbers are valid if one has the same numbers in all upper- case format, or mixed-case format. Example:  
NIST SBBCDE22B2222  
NIST SB**b**CDE22B2222
- Previously, the iEdison help content displayed the telephone format of "123-456-7890" for all telephone fields, while the web displayed on the screens "(123) 456-7890". The iEdison help content format also only applies to NANP format, and other formats are allowed for Non-NANP countries.
- When the Title Election Date on an EIR is not allowed, an unclear message displays upon submission. Previously it stated: "Title Election Date is not allowed when the invention status is not 'Elect Title' or 'Licensed as an Unpatented Biological Material or Research Tool'". This message will be revised to read: "Title Election Date is allowed only when the invention status is 'Elect Title' or 'Licensed as an Unpatented Biological Material or Research Tool'".
- An error has been fixed that occurred when an invention report was modified by adding an inventor who already existed for the invention, and when there were duplicate Grant numbers and/or Subcontracts.
- An error has been fixed that occurred upon selecting an Invention for Modification and then selecting the Cancel Button at the bottom of the page.
- A system error resulted when the following occurred. This has been fixed in the system:
  1. Log in as an NIH iEdison Accounts Administrator or an OTT admin.
  2. From the main menu, select "Search for an iEdison account to modify".
  3. For one of the accounts, select the "Update Account" button. Select "Cancel".
  4. Scroll down and select the "Return to Search Screen" button. A system error resulted.
